

The Bounty Ships Scheme to Australia

George Fyfe

The *George Fyfe* was the 16th of 20 Bounty Scheme ships. She sailed from Tobermory, Mull, on the 15th September 1839 and arrived in Sydney on 23rd January 1840, carrying 178 passengers, mainly from Argyll, Skye or Inverness. Those identified as having been born or having lived in **Coll** were:
