OBITUARY

Mr **Allan McLean** of Jerrar, an old and highly esteemed resident, passed over to the great majority on Saturday last. The cause of death was acute pleurisy. The deceased was a native of Tyree (Argyleshire). He came to colony in 1856 and had lived in the district 33 years and was in his 67th year. The remains were interred at Jamberoo on Sunday. The Rev. John Wilson MA officiated at the grave. Mr McLean was a Presbyterian and one of Mr Wilson's congregation.
